

# EVgo: BUILDING EV CHARGING STATIONS WITH NEVI

The **National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI)** program is a federal funding program that will pay for up to 80% of the cost to own and operate fast chargers at your qualifying locations.

## What Exactly Is NEVI Funding?

NEVI will fund fast charging at sites within one mile of designated interstate corridors, targeting fast charging every 50 miles. **Starting in Q1 2023, funds are available in competitive, time-limited programs.** Each state DOT is responsible for releasing its own solicitation, which contains details on preferred charging locations, selection criteria, and other requirements. At a minimum, each site must have four 150kW fast chargers.

After corridors, NEVI will fund additional sites in urban, suburban and other community locations. Details are TBD.

A minimally compliant NEVI charging station may cost ~\$500,000 - \$750,000. This is a brief window of time when federal funding will pay for the majority (up to 80%) of your electric vehicle charging equipment and installation costs, and in some cases, part of its operational cost.



**\$5 Billion** of federal funding is available to state Departments of Transportation (DOTs) to allocate to electric vehicle charging.



**Up to 80%** of the cost to own & operate fast chargers will be covered at your qualifying locations.



This revolutionary funding will be available for more than **10,000 fast charging locations.**

## When & How Do I Apply?

**Applications for Phase 1 corridor funding began opening in January 2023.** Each state oversees its own application, timeline, and review process.

The initial (Phase 1) NEVI corridor funding requires that sites be located within one mile of certain designated corridors in each state.
